



Winning films at FIFEM 2010

Montreal (March 9, 2010) ---- Delphis Films is proud to announce that two films from its world acclaimed family film collection won prizes at this year's 13th edition of the Montreal's International Children Film Festival (FIFEM).

The Crocodiles received the "Place aux familles / Place for Families" Award, a prize given by the Children's Jury. The film, directed by Christian Ditter, sold over 650,000 tickets during its German release by Constantin Film. This adventurous film is based on a novel and features a gang of kids who individually have shortcomings but who together, as a formidable team, crack local crimes. The film has won Cinekid Lion Prize as well as over ten awards from children's jury in Russia, Turkey, India, Finland, Belgium and Greece. The film is scheduled for release in Quebec later this year.

The International Jury awarded the "Grand Prize of Montreal" to *Eep!*. The film is based on an award-winning novel about a girl who happens to have wings instead of arms. The so-called world's "Littlest Angel" from Canada, Kenadie Jourdin-Bromley, delivers an incredible performance as the bird-like girl. The film was part of the official selection at Berlinale Generation and is headed for competition at more festivals worldwide.
